The Guardian is classified by helmet manufacturers as an "external enhancement device" and to date, no helmet manufacturers have stated in writing that the Guardian will affect their warranty. If your shell cracks and the helmet manufacturer refuses to replace it, citing Guardian as the reason, Guardian will cover the warranty and replace the shell for up to five (5) years, provided that the helmet has met all NOCSAE reconditioning requirements. Please note that no helmet, nor the Guardian, has a warranty that includes liability. Consumer assumes risk when choosing to use Guardian Caps.

WHY DO WE GIVE THIS WARRANTY?

Because we don't want red tape to be the reason your athlete doesn't utilize the extra impact reduction the Guardian provides. It is the coach and parental right to choose equipment for their athletes. We want to do everything we can to allow you to exercise this right without the worry of potentially losing money on a great product you've already purchased.

GUARDIAN™ DISCLAIMER

No helmet or cap can prevent 100% of serious head or neck injuries a player might receive while playing a contact sport. Do not use the Guardian™ to butt, ram, or spear an opposing player. This is in violation of contact sport rules and such use can result in severe head or neck injuries, paralysis or death to you and possible injury to your opponent. Contact to the head in sports may result in concussion-brain injury, which no helmet can prevent. Symptoms include: loss of consciousness or memory, dizziness, headache, nausea, or confusion. If you have symptoms, stop playing immediately and report them to your coach, trainer, and parents. Do not return to a game or practice until all symptoms are gone and you have received medical clearance. Ignoring this warning may lead to another more serious or fatal brain injury.
